## Charges for School Activities

The Governors of this school have determined the following policy on charging :

- (1) Where we are allowed to charge, each activity relating to the curriculum will be assessed, and charges may be made or voluntary contributions, where appropriate, may be requested.
- (2) Where parents or guardians are in receipt of
  - Income Support
  - Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
  - Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit and annual income not exceeding £16,190)
  - Guarantee element of pension credit
  - Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
  - Universal Credit – from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 provided annual net earned income is no more than £7,400
  - Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act

the following will apply :

- (i) For residential visits, they are not required to pay for board and lodging for their child.
- (ii) For all educational visits, contributions will be regarded as voluntary but visits will only take place subject to the receipt of sufficient funds.

Remission of fees in all the above cases is subject to evidence of receipt of qualifying benefits being shown on the date of the parents/guardians application for the child's inclusion in the activity.
