Reading:

'The Pea and the Princess' and other texts to develop our skills of comprehension.

Writing: An Anthology of Animals:

We will:

- write an information page on two different animals.
- use paragraphs to group related information.
- use conjunctions to expand sentences.
- use adverbs and prepositions to indicate where and when something is.



Computing: Databases We will:

- learn how to search for information in a database
- contribute to a class database
- create a database around a chosen topic



DT:

We will:

- Identify major food groups.
- Explain the importance of a balanced diet.
- Prepare and cook a simple dish.
- Suggest improvements to finished dishes.



PE: Dance and Football

We will:

- copy and repeat set choreography
- confidently perform different styles of dance, showing a good sense of timing

Our mathematical learning will focus on

- Length and Perimeter: Measure lengths in millimetres, centimetres and metres, compare lengths, add and subtract lengths and measure the perimeter of a shape
- Fractions: Find equivalent fractions, compare fractions and add simple fractions to make a whole

Geography: Agriculture

We will:

We will:

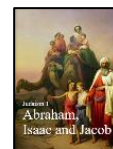
- learn about The King of Kings
