



## Home School Agreement

A Home School Agreement is a statement explaining our school aims, values, policies and procedures, responsibilities towards our pupils, the responsibilities of yourselves as parents/carers, and what's expected of our pupils.

At Morley Meadow Primary and Nursery, we recognise each child as an individual, and aim to give all children every opportunity to reach their full potential through our school values 'Ask, Aspire, Achieve.' We believe that a close partnership between the school, parents and the child is essential if we are to achieve this aim.

It is therefore an expectation that all parents who wish their children to attend Morley Meadow Primary and Nursery will sign up to our Home School Agreement. We also ask parents to ensure they share the Home School Agreement with their child, and we will also discuss this in school.

### School

The school will endeavour to:

- provide a broad and balanced curriculum which challenges your child to reach their potential and fulfils the requirements of the National Curriculum, meeting children's individual needs.
- provide a safe, happy and inspiring environment where all children are valued, respected and listened to.
- care for children's safety, welfare and well-being.
- achieve high standards of behaviour by providing opportunities for children to develop positive social relationships, self-esteem, and a sense of responsibility.
- promote high standards and high expectations of effort and attainment.
- keep you informed about your child's progress and behaviour, as well as their termly curriculum.
- provide regular home learning opportunities which are realistic, achievable and related to work in school.
- allow children safe and secure use of the Internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and by fostering a responsible attitude in all children, in partnership with parents.
- promote good attendance and punctuality.
- keep parents well informed about school life and special events through regular communication e.g. Class Dojo, the school website, general meetings.

### Parent/Carer

As parents/carers we will endeavour to:

- support the school by accepting it's aims, policies and procedures, positively; having chosen Morley Meadow Primary and Nursey for our child.
- ensure that my child attends school regularly, is punctual, in the correct uniform and properly equipped and ready to learn.
- notify the school by email or telephone in the event of absence.
- promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school.
- attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss my child's progress and get to know about their life at school.
- support my child with home learning, including listening to my child read regularly.

- regularly read information on Class Dojo, the website and school communication via Teachers2Parents so that I am kept-up-to-date with important details of relevant policies, meetings, events and information about my child.
- keep the school informed of any changes in circumstances (i.e. address, phone number, emergency contacts etc.)
- support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- respect all members of the school community, abiding by the school Communication Charter
