We will learn to:

- read individual letters by saying the sounds for them
- blend sounds to read short words
- read a few common exception words
- engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- recognise and write our name
- develop confidence to make a mark
- retell the story of 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'



## Mathematical

We will learn to:

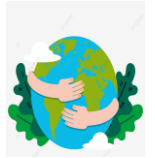
- solve real world problems with numbers up to 5
- count actions, objects and sounds up to 10
- compare numbers to 5
- select shapes appropriately for a purpose
- combine shapes to make new ones
- make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity



## Understanding of the World:

We will learn to:

- talk about members of our immediate family and community
- name and describe people who are familiar to us
- comment on images of familiar situations in the past
- notice and talk about the signs of Autumn



## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will learn to:

- sustain focus for longer at chosen and directed activities
- begin to bounce back after difficulties
- make healthy choices about food and drink
- express our feelings
- manage our own personal hygiene

## Physical Development:

We will learn to:

- refine the fundamental movement skills
- use our core muscle strength to achieve a good posture
- find a space, freeze on command, use and share equipment and work individually, with a partner and group



## How I can help my child this term:

- share books at home every day with your child
- talk about the books that you share and explore new and interesting words
- sing counting songs and rhymes
- practice writing your child's name using lower case letters
- practice the sounds that your child is learning in Read Write Inc
- attend the Read Write Inc workshop (date to follow)
- attend Stay and Play session (date to follow)

## PSHE (Jigsaw):

We will learn to:

- about belonging and that we are similar and different
- recognise my feelings and start to manage them
- enjoy working with others
- understand why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands
- understand that we should all be allowed to learn and play
- understand what being responsible means



## Communication and Language:

We will learn to:

- understand a 3-part instruction
- sing a large repertoire of songs
- sing rhymes, talk about familiar books, and tell a long story.
- understand 'why' questions
- express a point of view and to debate we they disagree



## Wild Tribe:

We will learn to:

- change into our outdoor clothes independently
- understand the importance of safety rules and follow them
- listen to and follow instructions
- notice and talk about the signs of Autumn



## Expressive Art and Design:

We will learn to:

- mix colours for a desired purpose
- experiment with different shades and tones
- draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details
- sing the melodic shape (moving melody, such as up and down, down and up) of familiar songs
- explore and engage in music making
