

Read Write Inc. Phonics

Reading

Read, Write Inc – Children will read in school every day and bring either a reading book or sheet home to share each day.

Writing

Children will learn to write simple sentences with a focus on full stops, capital letters and fingers spaces.

Computing – Lego Builders

We will:

- Understand what an algorithm is
- Create and follow simple instructions on a computer

- prepare fruits by slicing, chopping and mashing.

Addition and subtraction within 10: add and subtract pairs of numbers to make answers that are below 10.
