Read, Write Inc – We will continue to master the Set 3 sounds. Children will read in school every day and bring a reading book to read with an adult at home on Fridays.



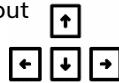
### Writing

- Understand timelines

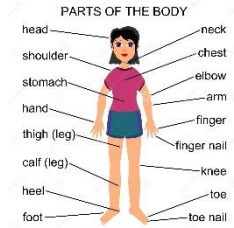
### How I can help my child this term:

- discuss the foods we eat and how it is grown and prepared to eat.
- count in 2s, 5s and 10s to 100.
- discuss the cost of things and the coins we may use to pay for things
- explore photos showing changes from babies to children and adulthood.
