During this term the children in Goldfinch class will be busy! In history, they will be learning all about ancient Greece. We will launch this area of learning with an exciting introduction during our Greek Food Tasting Day on 10th September. During the term, children will explore the battle of Marathon, find out about Greek daily life and learn about the Greek soldiers. In DT, the children will be making decoy vessels, using mechanisms such as levers, gears winding mechanisms and pulleys. Science will be focused on understanding how animals including humans need nourishment through healthy diet and how we should look after our bodies. PE days will be on a Monday and Thursday and Miss Lyon will be teaching Wild Tribe on a Wednesday. PE kit and Wild Tribe clothing needs to be named and in school at all times. Thank you.
